Peer Review Process

The essential responsibility related to the editorial board members and independent reviewers is to review submitted papers. In this context, it is required to ensure an optimum evaluation quality in the reviewing process. As general, submitted papers are reviewed by two reviewers (chosen from editorial board or/and database of independent reviewers). At this point, the following rules are followed:

- In the review process, the chosen reviewers are responsible for returning their reviews within 2 weeks after receiving the paper.
 - Before a reviewer receives the submitted full paper, he/she is asked whether or not he/she has enough time to review the paper. If he/she agrees, then the submitted full paper is provided by desiring the completed review form to receive within 2 weeks.
 - Editorial board members are responsible for reviewing at least 7 submitted papers per year.

Open Access Policy

JOMUDE provides immediate online open access to its content on the principle that making research freely available to the public supports a greater global exchange of knowledge.

Publication Frequency

As default, JOMUDE publish online 4 issues in a year per 1 volume. The issues are approximately in January, April, July, and October. In addition, there may be an additional issue in December in case of specific situations like too many accepted papers waiting for publication, special issues...etc.
